Entry forms to be accompanied with full payment for selected classes and received by the closing date of May 10th 2016, otherwise pre entry will be deemed invalid.

N.B Equine Premises Registration number must be on the entry form in order for the entry to be accepted.

All entries are non refundable unless the Show is cancelled. If the show is postponed an option will be given to all paid up entrants to have their entries deferred to the new given date; should they choose not to have their entries deferred to the new date they can request in writing for a full refund of their entry fee/s.

All animals must be kept under control at all times. Failure to do this may result in the owner/handler being asked to remove themselves and their animal/s from the show grounds. If this is the case any entry fee/s will be forfeited.

We, the show, reserve the right to change, remove or add any given class as required, for example due to lack of entries or to split a class if appropriate.

We, the show reserve the right to refuse entry of an exhibitor to any class if it is deemed they are inappropriate to the class listing.

Stabling can be pre-booked at a rate of €10 per stable for the night prior to the show day. Request for stabling must be made and paid for in full along with the entry form. Stabling is limited and is on a first come first served basis only. You may wish to ring and confirm availability of stables. To do this, please ring the number on the schedule. Clearly state number of stables required. You will be allotted a number of your stable/s, please use only the stable with the number/s you have been allocated. All animals must be in the stables by 7pm on the night prior to the day of the show and out by 9am sharp the day of the show.

Anyone wishing to make entries on the day may do so at the rate of €15 per animal, per class and these entries must be in by 11am sharp to allow for admin prior to the commencement of the first class at 12pm sharp.

No entries after this time will be accepted.

All entrants are requested to be on the showground by 10am at the latest so as to facilitate parking and limit disruption for other classes already in progress.

In the interest of safety all exhibitors are asked to only enter the main arena through the collecting/warm up ring and to exit the main arena at the given exit. Not to enter and exit through the same gateway. In doing this there is no chance of two vehicles colliding.

Please be guided by the stewards as to the correct entry and exit of the Driving arena. We try to maintain as safe an environment as possible for all concerned so it is every ones interest to do so and make it as enjoyable and successful day for exhibitor and public alike.

The Judges decision is final.

We, the Show, and/or its representatives, reserve the right to refuse entry of any exhibitor to any class if it is deemed the vehicle and or animal/s are not fit for the purpose and possibly pose a risk to the public and or other competitors, or themselves.

Neither the show, grounds owner, person/s representing the show can be held liable for any loss, damage to any vehicle, animal or possession whilst you are attending the show and you are there at their own risk.

We, the show, strongly advise that all exhibitors have their own insurance for themselves, their vehicles/animals/belongings.
